Sub-Compulsory Medical examination of ATCOs –Reg.

Dear All,

At the outset CEC acknowledges the solidarity shown by all Branches and adopting identical resolutions in conveying their grievances against medical examination before 31.12.2017. In this regard, a letter was submitted to Member (ANS), copy to Chairman, mentioning related issues as a prelude to conduct of medical examination.

Member (ANS) had convened a meeting attended by CEC members and other senior executives viz. ED(ATM), ED(CAP), ED(ATM-TRG), GM(CAP) and Jt.GM (ATM-HRD).

Following points were discussed in the meeting:-

- 8) **Suitable/serviceable of CNS equipment**


Detailed discussions took place on above mentioned issues in addition to problems being faced by ATCO's on implementation of Two-stream rating. It was conveyed categorically that there will not be any financial loss to controllers for which suitable instructions will be issued soon. Also, a meeting has been scheduled in first week of January 2018 wherein the availability of channels and hours requirement for drawl of stress allowance will be discussed.

The record of discussion of today's meeting will be released tomorrow. CEC is satisfied with the progress of the meeting and the action plan.

In view of the above, CEC requests all Regional and Branch Secretaries to cooperate with GMs/ATS-in charges and advise members for medical examination as per the roster prepared to complete by 5th Jan 2018. It is also stated that priority for the medical examination will be given to the rated ATCOs followed by the OJTs. Those who don't have any ratings or undergoing training are exempted from this timeline.

We will continue to post the developments on this issue as and when situation warrants.
