



Minutes of CEC Meeting held on 15 January 2020

Central Executive Council (CEC) Meeting was held on 15.01.2020 at IGI Airport and the following members attended the meeting:

At the outset, the Vice President welcomed all members and started the proceedings. The agenda items circulated by the General Secretary through notice for CEC meeting was adopted and some additional agenda items were also discussed with the permission of chair. The following issues were discussed and resolved:

1. Activity Report of the General Secretary

- 1.1. Discussion took place on the following activities which were taken up by the Guild since taking over of the General Secretary on 1st November 2019 :
 - 1.1.1. Delay in construction of quarters at Mumbai
 - 1.1.2. Inordinate delay in credential verifications of Junior Executives (ATC) and consequences
 - 1.1.3. Revision of Instructor allowance and OJT Instructor Allowance
 - 1.1.4. Introduction of meal cards in AAI
 - 1.1.5. Review of conditions of CHRM 61/2019
 - 1.1.6. Alarming Level of Degradation of ATS Facilities in Chennai OCC Airspace
 - 1.1.7. Civil Aviation Requirement (CAR) regarding Breath Analyser test for Air Traffic Controllers
 - 1.1.8. Introducing National Pension System (NPS) in place of AAIEDCPS
 - 1.1.9. Inordinate delay in conduct of credential verifications of Junior Executives (ATC) recruited in 2016

Varanasi branch has requested for a grant of rupees of 32000/- to meet the expenditure incurred in conducting various activities on the occasion of World ATC Day. The approval could not be

reflected in the minutes of the Central Council Meeting held on 21 October 2019 inadvertently. CEC approves Rs. 32000/- to Varanasi Branch.

5. **Participation in the 59th IFATCA Annual Conference 2020**

The Guild will write to the AAI Chairman for sponsorship of delegates to attend the IFATCA Annual Conference.


6. **Payment of IFATCA Membership Fee pending**

The IFATCA Membership payment for the year 2019/2020 will be made.

7. **SCAP Course**

The meeting acknowledged that 32 trainees are being sent to the SCAP course is mainly due to efforts made to this end by ATC Guild (India).
