



Minutes of CEC Meeting held on 6 May 2020

Central Executive Council (CEC) Meeting was held on 06.05.2020 through webinar due to COVID-19 restrictions.

Following members attended the meeting:

At the outset, the Vice President welcomed all members and started the proceedings.

The agenda items as articulated by the General Secretary were adopted.

The following issues were discussed and resolved:

1. Advocates fee

It was resolved that the Advocates' fees for the case filed by ATC guild (I) for the suspension of mandatory breath analyser test of ATCO's all over India, will be paid as soon as possible after the lockdown ends.

2. Court case filed at Kochi

It was also resolved that the CEC will monitor support for the court case filed by the Kochi Branch for the suspension of mandatory breath analyser test of ATCO's in Kerala high court.

3. IFATCA membership fee

It was resolved that the pending IFATCA Membership Fee to be paid as soon as possible after the lockdown ends.

4. Support to Eastern Region for its activities to help COVID-19 victims

CEC approves payment of Rs. 50000 to Eastern Region towards expenses made by them to help COVID-19 victims. This amount shall be adjusted against the CEC share dues of the Eastern Region.

5. Advise to all Regions/Branches

It was resolved to advise that henceforth all RS/BS shall take prior permission from CEC before spending money from ATC Guild accounts for any purpose whatsoever. It was also resolved that General Secretary will write mail to all RS/BS for deposit of Membership fee up to March 2020 within 15 day upon receipt of mail.

6. Payment of internet access and telephone

Internet access charges to be paid to Joy Bhattacharya, Member Secretary as soon as possible.

7. CEC 2020 Elections

CEC requests the Election Commission to announce new dates for elections as soon as possible.

8. ELPA/MEDICAL/Currency – Recency authentication

The GS will get in touch with the management to request for extending ELPA/PELA authentications to JUNE 2020 for ATCOS whose ELPA/PELA authentications is expected to expire soon.

9. APD allowances

It was resolved that the GS will write to the AAI management to stop deducting APD allowances.
