Sub: Addition of Sub-urban areas of Delhi and Mumbai in Loans & Advances Circular and increase in limit of car advance for E1 to E3 officers—reg.

Sir,

ATC Guild (I) welcomes the revision of loans and advances for executives vide CHRM circular no. 09/2019 dated 06.02.2019. As per this Circular, House Building Advance (HBA) has been revised to **75 lacs for Delhi and Mumbai**. It is worth to mention that the sub-urban areas of Delhi and Mumbai are equally costlier like Delhi and Mumbai, as lots of projects are coming up in these sub-urban areas with good transport system like Delhi Metro, Noida metro for Delhi NCR region and same in Mumbai and sub-urban areas also. Employees are willing to buy residential houses in these sub-urban areas also may be considered as eligible for 75 lacs of HBA amount. Hence, it is requested that in eligibility of HBA amount 75 lacs for Delhi and Mumbai may please be revised to Delhi-NCR and Mumbai & Sub-urban areas of Mumbai.

2. Reference may also be made to Car advance revision vide CHRM circular no. 09/2019 dt. 06.02.2019. Car advance for E1-E3 has been enhanced by 1 lac only. As per the proposal submitted by ATC Guild (I), it was 8 lacs for E3-E5. The officers joining at E1 level are going to serve AAI for 30-35 years, have a reasonably good repaying capacity, hence, it is reiterated that their car advance amount may please be revised to 8 lacs for E1-E5 officers.

We request your good office to incorporate the above mentioned suggestions and amend the circular to boost the morale of hundreds of young officers in AAI.
