Subject: Preventive measures to contain the spread of COVID-19, attendance of AAI officials – reg.

Sir,

Our Nation is facing an unprecedented rise in the numbers of COVID-19 cases and the capital town, New Delhi is facing its worst phase of COVID spread. AAI officials working at CHQ and other establishments are having so much fear as the disease is spreading at a faster pace in second wave resulting in more deaths than its first wave in previous year. It is appreciable that some of the HODs have already allowed junior officials of their section to work from home but senior officers are forced to come daily which creates a panic situation among these senior officers and their family members. As the condition in capital is becoming worse with all the medical facilities like COVID beds, Oxygen, ICU beds almost exhausted, the only option left out is to be inside home to contain the spread of this disease. It is very painful to inform you that we have lost one of our young officer Shri Abhishek Chandra, Manager (ATM-DoAS) working at CHQ due to COVID on 17th April 2021, and some of our officers are battling for their life on ventilator in hospitals.

We request your good office to save your employees' life and allow all the officials below JGM/DGM level to work from home as far as practicable till the time COVID spread is under control. The number of senior officers (DGM and above) also be kept at barest minimum as these officers are in the higher side of age and are more susceptible to this disease. An early action from head of the organisation will boost the morale of employees during this crisis.
